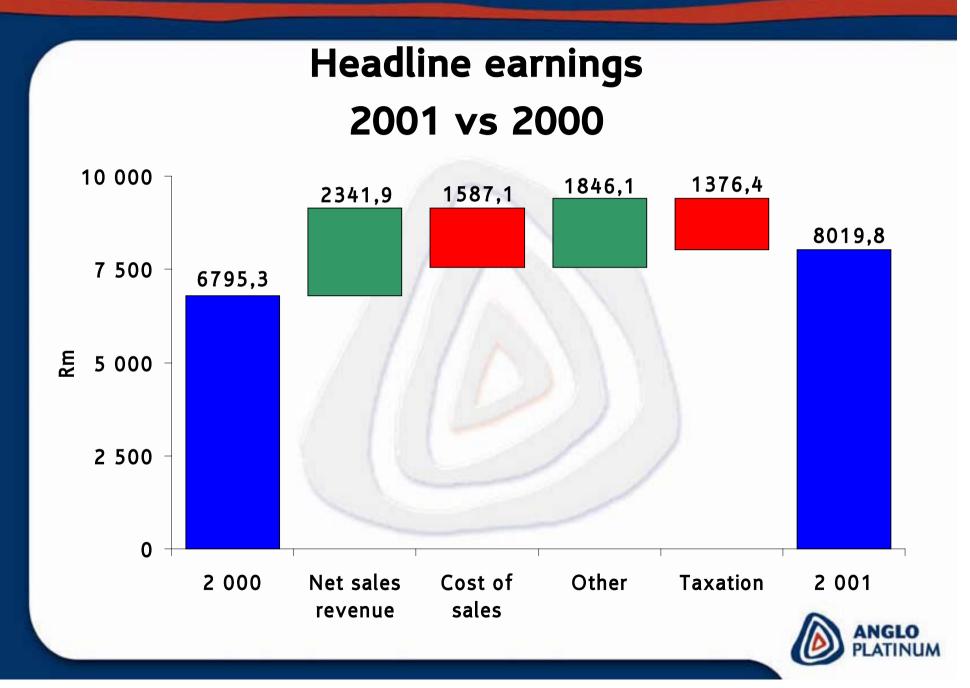

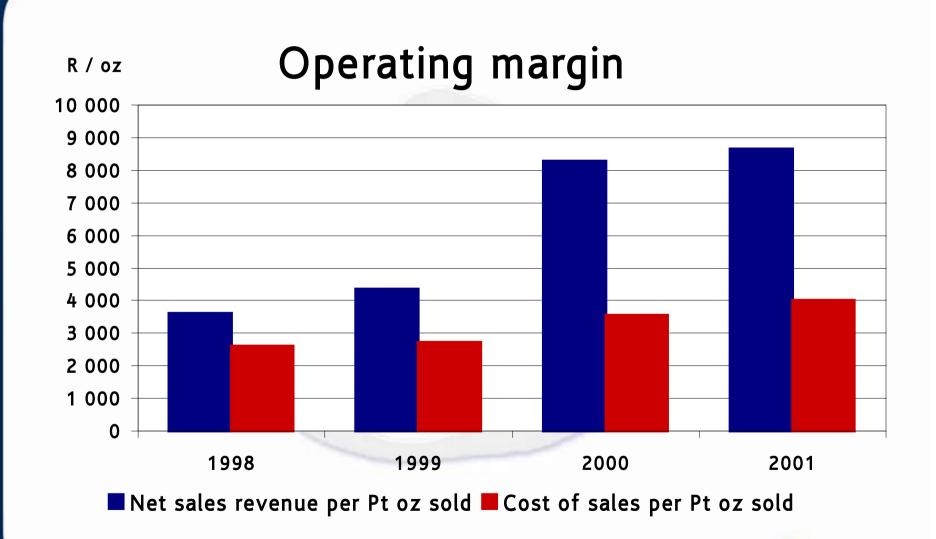

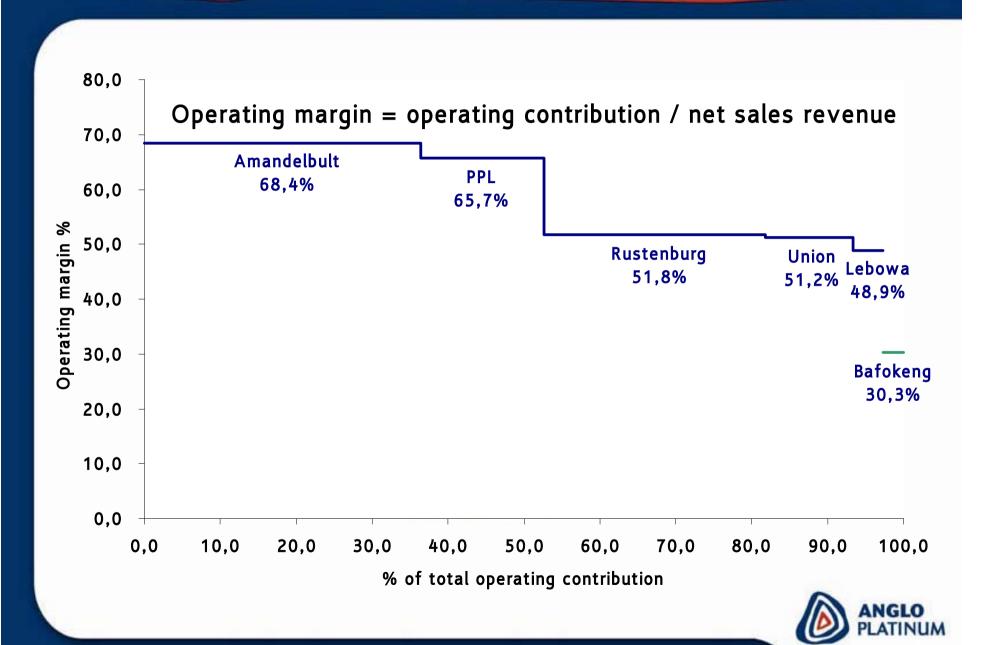


Basket of metals - Revenue vs cost

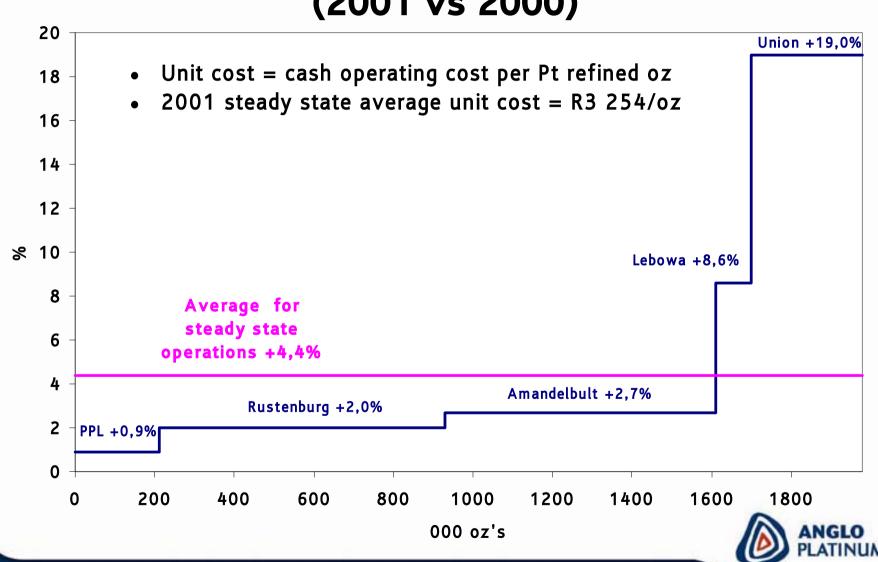

Income statement - Cost of sales

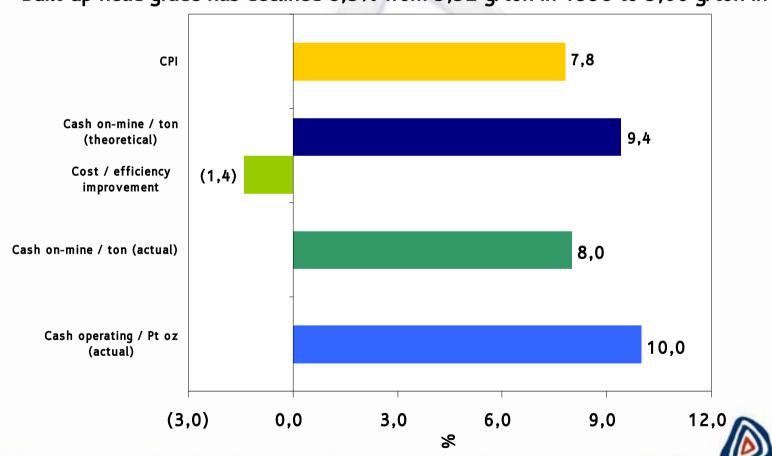
Increase in unit cost for steady state operations (2001 vs 2000)

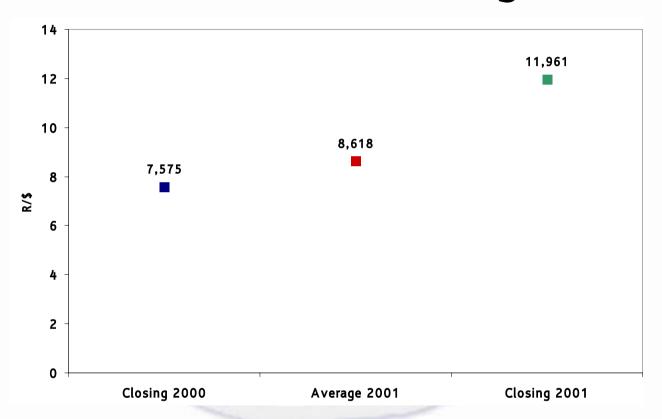
Compound increase in unit cost for steady state operations (1998 to 2001)

Rand / US dollar exchange rate



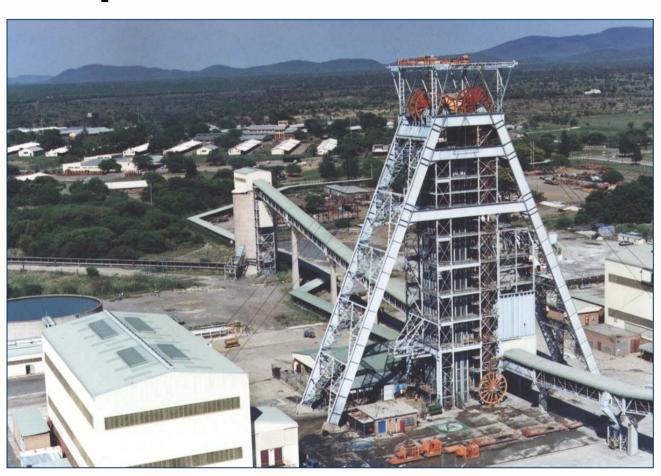
